

TEBIN Workforce Development Program Award

The purpose of this award is to annually recognize an institution demonstrating an outstanding and/or innovative workforce training program. Any institutional member of TEBIN may submit nominations for the award.

Award Criteria

The newly developed TEBIN program:

- Must be easily replicated at other institutions and must be less than three years old. (25 points)
- Must be driven by workforce demand demonstrated by how the training impacted the community need. (25 points)
- Must reflect originality in approach, content, and delivery. (25 points)
- Must be able to provide a letter of support from client/organization in support of the nomination and verification of benefits. This letter of support should be from outside the college. (25 points)

Proposals should be limited to no more than three total pages. The original should be submitted along with two additional copies. All award submissions must be received by program committee chair by March 19th, 2009. Award nominations will be judged by the committee on an independent basis and ranked using the point method system listed above.

The winner of this award will represent TEBIN and be submitted on behalf of the organization to the National Council Continuing Education Training (NCCET) program award competition. The statewide winner must agree to submit the program and comply with the guidelines for national consideration. If chosen by NCCET as a national program award winner, TEBIN will pay conference registration for this individual. Travel fees in addition to the registration fee will be the responsibility of the institution and the individual. The state award will be presented at the conference in May.
